- Increase understanding of how past trauma and other factors can impact parenting.
- Enhance relationships with families through partnering skills and reflection.
- Understand the steps of empathetic communication.
- Learn and identify concrete strategies and steps you can take right away to improve your relationships with families and their engagement.
